### Practicum/Apprenticeship – Pt 105-O,205-O/Pt 307-O,407-O (1-2 Credits)

Students can gain credit for the work they are currently doing in their local church. Students pursuing an Associate in Theology can get one credit for 30 hours of ministry work and students pursuing an Associate in Church Leadership can get two credits for 60 hours of ministry experience. All full-time students are required to register for Practicum or Apprenticeship.
