Every Other Year Courses to be offered Fall 2021

Juniors and Seniors, if any of these courses are required under your track please take the course this semester. It will not be offered again until Fall 2022.

Wisdom Literature – Bi415

Ken Malmin, 3 Credits

King Solomon declares that wisdom is worth more than any monetary value. The pursuit of wisdom is one of the greatest keys of life. This course explores Job, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, and the Song of Solomon with an emphasis on the understanding and the pursuit of wisdom. The study of the distinct literary forms of these books in their biblical context is combined with personal and practical application for a dynamic look of the biblical Wisdom Literature.

Minor Prophets – Bi423

Travis Arnold, 2 Credits

An analysis of biblical prophecies as expressed in the Minor Prophets considering both natural and historical significance and their relevance today. Special attention is given to Messianic prophecies involving Christ and the Church, prophetic ministry, and the personal application of their timeless truths.

Important Information for Music Students

General (Music-Related):

- All PBC students are eligible to take private lessons as an elective course. Once you select and register for a private lesson course in Populi, the Mannahouse Music School office will contact you in order to assist in booking potential instructors/lesson times. Thursdays will also include PBC Chapel (evening) and possible Mannahouse weekend rehearsals, and should be considered an essential day of the week to have free for music students and any students wanting to take Workshop class as an elective. Students are encouraged to select this day of the week as their day off work commitments as possible, to dedicate to musical growth and rehearsals.

Sophomores:

- Life of Christ, Local Church are courses that fulfill the Bible elective for all sophomore music students (only one of these courses required). Note: Pentateuch is not an available Bible elective this fall due to a schedule conflict.

Juniors & Seniors:

- Leading People is an every other year course offering, and is not available Fall 2021 for Jr and Sr Music students.
- Junior music students should take Mentoring Epistles (Bi 443) this fall instead.

Theology (Worship Ministry Emphasis):

- 1st Year: You will be eligible to take Worship Ministry 1 this fall if you test out of Intro to College Writing (English Proficiency Entrance exam). Otherwise, we will look to add this to your Fall 2022 schedule.
