Juniors and Seniors: If you need to take this class for your emphasis please register for the course this semester as it will not be offered next year. Description: A study in the nature & practice of leadership as it applies to both individuals and groups.

Teaching Techniques- Ce213

Credits

This course is composed of a variety of teaching techniques that can be adapted to various age groups, class sizes and educational situations. The student will learn and analyze several educational philosophies and theories as they relate to teaching. Emphasis will be placed on the characteristics of the learner in areas such as human development from birth through adult, learning styles and brain development. Characteristics of the teacher will also be studied as well as different teaching styles, including the place of technology and how to communicate to a changing world. Special attention will be given to teaching in cross-cultural settings and to the illiterate.

Important Information for Music Students

General (Music-Related):

- All PBC students are eligible to take private lessons as an elective course. Once a private lesson course is selected and registered for in Populi, the Mannahouse Music School office will contact you in order to assist in booking potential instructors/lesson times. - Worship Workshop is held Thu afternoons, 1:00-2:30 PM. PBC Chapel and Mannahouse weekend rehearsals generally take place Thursday evenings, and should be considered an essential day of the week for music students to have free. Students are encouraged to select Thursdays as their day off from work commitments as possible, to dedicate to musical growth and rehearsals.
- All freshman/sophomore music students: **Pt100 Freedom** is required to be taken in any of the first four (4) semesters, completed for Associates degree fulfillment.

- **Mu243 Worship Leading Techniques 2** is now **Mu243 Worship Leading Techniques (only)** - Adjustment to the name of this course, all sophomores (or elective students) who took **Mu 144 Worship Leading Techniques 1** should register for this course.
- **Bi105 Life of Christ** - is now the single required theology course for fall sophomore music students
