

PBC and IWU Concurrent Degree Program

Academic Policies

1. Students need to maintain a minimum accumulative GPA of 2.0 to participate.
2. Students must achieve a minimum of a C grade in each course they wish to transfer between PBC and IWU institutions.
3. A minimum of 30 credits must be completed at IWU to receive an IWU bachelor's degree and a minimum of 64 credits must be completed at PBC to receive a PBC bachelor's degree.
4. PBC offers a pathway where students can complete two bachelor's degrees in four years with the addition of a few summer courses, but PBC does *not guarantee* that students will complete all requirements in four years. [ie. Student's grades might not qualify, students may choose lighter credit loads, or they might start later.]
5. Not all 33 concurrent degrees can be completed in four years. Some PBC/IWU concurrent degree program options will require an additional one or two terms due to the different requirements. [ie Bachelor of Business or Bachelor of Human Services].
6. Students can start IWU online courses the summer AFTER their sophomore year. Students that desire to begin sooner, must have established a 3.0 GPA in their PBC coursework.
7. Freshman students (determined by credits) are not permitted to be dually enrolled.
8. Transfer students may start the application for IWU during their 2nd PBC semester for admittance in the summer if they have completed 48 credits and are in good academic standing.
9. International Students must maintain a full-time courseload (minimum 12 credits) of in-person classes in order to remain in the U.S., but can add IWU online courses to that load. International students may need to complete their IWU degree online from their home country if PBC degree is completed first.

Scheduling Policies

1. PBC in-person classes meet on a 16-week schedule with classes offered every morning between 7:30 and 12:00pm.
2. PBC online classes meet on a 15-week, asynchronous schedule and in a 7-week summer term.
3. IWU has four terms per year. Online courses operate on a 6-week schedule. Students take one IWU course at a time, but can take two courses, per term.
4. Primary start for IWU online courses are in the months of June, August, November and March.
5. To complete both Bachelors in four years, students must start by taking two IWU online courses no later than the summer after their sophomore year.
6. Students that need extra semesters to finish their dual degree may have an option to remain on-campus at PBC even if PBC course requirements are completed, but this is not guaranteed.
7. Students using US Pell Grants need to be enrolled full-time at IWU (2 courses back-to-back in one term).
