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O: How much do classes cost?

Students can sign-up for an interest free payment plan of four equal monthly payments, always due on the first of the month. For more information, visit the Tuition & Fees page on our website.

Q: When are courses offered?

Online courses are offered in a semester system. The Fall semester begins after Labor Day in September and the Spring semester begins the first week of February. There is also an intensive, seven-week Summer semester that begins the first week of June. All courses are offered at least once a year, either in the Fall or Spring Semesters. A limited number of core courses are repeated in the Summer term.

Q: How much time does an online course take each week?

This will depend on the course. Lectures typically range between 35-45 minutes in length. Two credit courses will require between 3-5 hours of work each week and three credit courses require between 4-6 hours per week. Often students think taking courses online means less work and less time. This is simply not the case. Online classes require the same amount of work as a typical college class on a campus. The benefit of taking courses online is the flexibility it offers.

Q: What are the technical requirements?

An iPad or mobile phone will not be sufficient for completing your college coursework. In order to be successful in online classes, students need a computer with some version of Microsoft Word or Mac Pages in order to submit assignments. You'll also need access to a high-speed internet connection with a reliable web browser like Firefox or Google Chrome to play your lectures.

Q: What is an online course like?

Online courses are structured in a very similar format to traditional classroom learning. Courses are organized into 14-week lessons. Students are assigned a series of tasks each week to be completed by Monday midnight PST. Assignments could include reading, watching lectures, participating in discussion forums, taking tests or submitting papers. All of these activities are done within Populi, our student information system.

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Q: What if I'm out of town, on vacation, or unavailable while class is in session?

If you have a laptop or can get online, class can always be in session! That's the flexibility of online education. Online courses do not meet at a certain time or on a given day, but course work must be completed by Monday midnight pacific time each week. Like any course, there are due dates for assignments, therefore, traveling students should plan accordingly and complete work early.

Q: Do I need a pastor's reference even if I am not pursuing a degree at PBC?

The mission of PBC is building leaders that serve local churches around the world. A pastoral reference is the one piece of information that demonstrates a student's connection to the local church. The pastor does not need to be Senior Pastor. It can be an Associate Pastor, Youth Pastor, Elder or the like; however, they must be able to speak to the students' involvement in the local church.

Q: Can I get credit for my service in the local church?

PBC offers up to 4 credits of Practicum to students pursuing an Associate degree and up to 8 credits of Apprenticeship to students pursuing a Bachelor's degree. Each credit requires at least 30 hours of service over a 14-week semester in a local church during.

Q: I haven't taken a college course in a very long time; do I have what it takes to be successful?

Don't let this intimidate or scare you from the Bible education you desire. While, it may be weird to have assignments, due dates and grades again, you will be surprised by how rewarding it is to interact with people on new topics and to realize how much you have learned at the end of the process. It truly is never too late to be a college learner. All you need is a deep desire to learn and the personal discipline to follow through on that desire.

Q: I don't want college credit; can I still get access to the content?

Students can audit online courses through the Independent Study program. This option removes the assignment requirements and gives a student access to the lectures and student notes for six months. Students auditing courses do not need to be accepted to PBC. Audit courses do not count toward degree requirements. Browse courses at www.pbcaccess.com

Q: Can I download the course content?

All PBC courses offer handouts and comprehensive course notes that every student can download and keep when the course is done. However, students are not able to download the actual course lectures.



PRIOR MINISTRY EXPERIENCE

Students can apply to receive up to 20 credits for previous ministry experience! While life experience is valuable, learning credit is granted based on the student's ability to prove retention of information, articulate learning outcomes, and demonstrate the application of lessons learned. To receive credit, students submit learning applications and essays that are assessed by faculty members for granting credit.

CURRENT MINISTRY EXPERIENCE

Students can receive up to 12 credits for current ministry experience. Some of the Holy Spirit's best work in our lives happens as we are focused on serving others, and ministry skills are best developed in a purposeful context that includes accountability, mentoring and evaluation. For every semester, students who are enrolled in courses, can add either Practicum (30hrs of serving) or Apprenticeship (60hrs of serving) each semester.

SUMMER TERM

PBC offers a summer term that makes a select number of one and two credit courses available to students that desire to increase their annual credit loads in order to complete degree programs in less time. The summer term condenses the course workloads of a full 14-week term into 7 weeks.

2-DAY INTENSIVES

Every March, PBC partners with Mannahouse Church to offer a series of ministry courses that fit one credit of lectures into two days. This intensive experience grants students up to one credit each year. Students will complete a book and a paper after the intensive to qualify for credit.
